

USER SERVICES

CONSULTATION

Free access to all bibliographic material in the library (open shelving). Consultation is allowed to all categories of users. The issues of the printed magazines, currently under subscription, are on display in the special exhibitors located in the two newspaper libraries.



LOAN

The book lending service is open to students, teaching and non-teaching staff, subject experts and external users.

Furthermore, the book loan service of the Right to Study Institution was activated in 2003 for the students of the University of Turin. The loan regulations are available on the Library website.

PC PRINTS AND PHOTOCOPIES

Photocopies of documents and PC printing are integrated into a single paid service.

It is in fact possible to (where provided, within the limits of the law):

- - photocopy documents in both A4 and A3 format, both in black and white and in color;
- -print documents from your USB pendrive;
- -scan documents by sending them to your USB pendrive.

INTERNET ACCESS

All students can access the Internet with their University credentials.

It is possible to:

- surf on the web;
 - download, save and view the teaching material on a USB pendrive;
 - create documents with the Office 2013 program.
- The University WiFi is accessible both inside and outside the Library.

EXTENSION, RESERVATION AND LOAN REQUEST

By accessing the Catalogo UniTo with the University credentials, it is possible to extend the loan (in the absence of a reservation by another user), reserve books on loan to other students, request the books available in the library from home, reserving them for five days.

CHAT

The chat is active from 9.00 am to 7.00 pm, from Monday to Friday and Saturday from 9.00 to 12.00 am. During this time slot it will be possible to contact directly – synchronously- the library staff.

DOCUMENT DELIVERY

Localization and retrieval of bibliographic material not owned by the Library, reserved for professors, researchers, doctoral students and undergraduates.



INTER-LIBRARY LOAN (ILL)

For users: Loan of volumes that the Library does not own, but which are kept in other Italian or foreign libraries, reserved for professors, researchers, doctoral students and undergraduates.

For requesting Libraries: Loan of volumes that the Library owns.



DIGITAL LIBRARY

In addition to the consultation of bibliographic material on paper, the Library offers its users many exam texts in ebook format and the possibility of accessing a vast choice of electronic resources that can also be consulted from home, available at the following addresses:

The staff of the Library offers complete support to users.

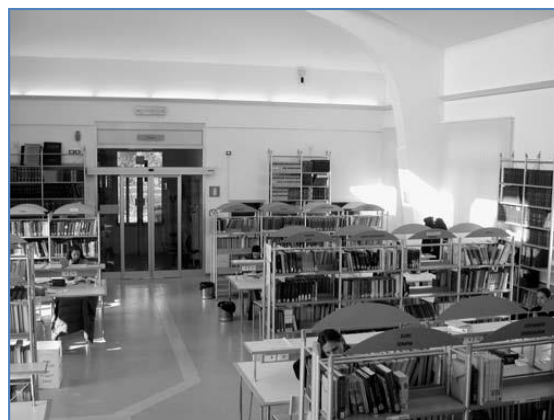
The Agroviet library carries out an instruction service in the use of bibliographic resources and management of bibliographies, through two modules lasting about 30 minutes each available on the university's moodle platform.



The Interdepartmental Library of Agricultural and Veterinary Sciences was inaugurated on November 14, 2003 and represents a unique documentation center to which the entire scientific community of teachers, researchers and students currently present on the Grugliasco campus belongs. The new and modern building has a total area of 1218 square meters, of which 756 on the ground floor, including offices, reading rooms, newspaper library. The remaining surface is allocated in the basement in a space intended as a book warehouse and equipped with compact shelving. From November 2020 is operative the **Diffuse Library**, an ambitious project, unique in the Turin University, which provides to all students a space of nearly 900 square meters dedicated to both individual and group study with 289 seats available.



The Library, open to teachers, researchers, students, experts in the subject and external users, has a reading room and two newspaper libraries, capable of accommodating about 106 users. In the reading room, the books are placed on open shelves and sorted by subject according to a classification scheme borrowed from the Utrecht University Library. The Library is equipped with an anti-theft system. Before entering the consultation room, users must deposit their bags in the appropriate lockers.



Library staff provides full reference service.

The Library can be reached by:

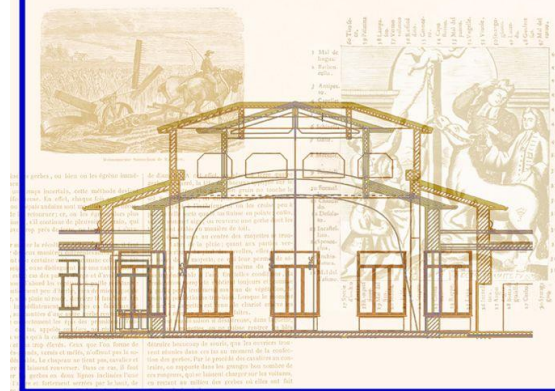
- underground: Fermi station and then public transport line 76 (Da Vinci stop) or line 64 (Turin stop) and then line 76.
